Tracking Camera

During a videoconference, manually controlling the camera so that the person speaking is visible at the far end can be a tedious task. With the optional PCSA-CTG70 tracking camera, this is no longer an issue. The following three modes are available:

Speaker Tracking Mode

Using voice-directional detection and face recognition functions, the camera automatically adjusts its angle and zoom settings to center the active speaker's face in the screen.

Next Face Centering Mode

The Remote Commander® unit can be used to pan the camera to the left and right so that it captures participant's faces one-by-one. This mode works in such a manner that when the camera is moved in either direction, the face recognition function automatically stops and centers the camera on the next participant that it locates.

Presenter Mode

In this mode, the camera uses movement detection to track and center a moving speaker. Presenter mode is ideal for use when you prefer to track a specific speaker, such as during a lecture.
